2024 Ladies' Shafter Rules of Play

Method of Scoring: Low Ball of the twosome using handicap designated on the scorecard.

Match Play:

Each team will play five 9-hole matches against the other teams in their flight. All 9 holes will be played in each match (even if a team is closed out), with one point being awarded for each hole won, ½ point awarded for each hole halved, zero points for losing a hole, and one point awarded for winning the match (½ point if the match is tied). There are a total of ten points available to be won in each match. However, the maximum number of points that can be won or lost in a match is 5, plus 1 for the win.

Handicaps: The handicaps listed are 9-hole handicaps.

- A team may concede the hole if it has no chance to win.
- Prizes will be awarded in each flight.
- In case of ties within each flight, we will use the match between the teams to decide the winner.

Matches Played at Full Handicap:

Matches are played at full handicap. The handicap is cut in half because of playing 9-hole matches.

Rules, Local Rules, and Information

All play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and local rules stated on this sheet. The rules of four-ball match play will apply.

1. Scores must be returned to the scoreboard by the scoring team as soon as possible after the completion of play. Sides must agree on the point total outcome, which will be recorded on the card.
2. All play will be from the red markers. Flight 4 will play from the family tee.
3. Out of Bounds- All boundary fences, the service road on #17, parking areas, and white stakes.
4. Through the green, a ball embedded in its own pitch mark except in sand or loose soil can be lifted and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible and no closer to the hole than where it originally laid.
5. Suspension or resumption of play:
Suspension- One long blast of a siren
Resumption- Three short blasts of a siren
*The tournament committee will determine if and when the course is playable.
6. The pond on #2 and #8 is marked partly as a penalty area.

Slow Play:

In consideration of all players, the following policy will be implemented for the tournament. In the event a group falls behind the normal pace of play, and there is a hole open, the group will be given a warning. If they fail to pick up the pace, the marshal will request the group to play each hole from the 150-yard marker until the gap is closed. No shots will be given. We hope you understand that this is done for the benefit of the field.

Slow play will not be tolerated.

The Tournament Committee has the right to adjust a player's handicap at any time throughout the tournament
